

**GLOUCESTER FARMERS MARKET - COMMUNITY STALL - CONDITIONS**

The Supplier acknowledges and agrees to the following **conditions**:

1. Goods to be delivered to Coordinator at the Stall within one hour prior to advertised Start Time. Acceptance of goods is at Coordinator’s discretion as to type, size, quantity, quality, packaging and appropriateness (in accordance with the Rules of the Gloucester Farmers Market).
2. Goods to be accompanied by a Tally Sheet, duly completed in unshaded spaces.
3. At time of delivery to the Stall, Supplier should nominate the desired price and the minimum price to be charged per unit (bag, pkt, doz, each etc); otherwise Coordinator may do so. Goods to be adequately packaged for convenient handling and presentation. Each box to be clearly marked with Supplier’s Name or Code Number and weigh no more than 15 kg. Each unit within the boxes should be priced and marked with Supplier’s Code Number.
4. Supplier may stipulate that certain goods unsold within 30 minutes of the Market Finish Time may be discounted to a price determined by the Coordinator (not less than the minimum price set), or may stipulate that certain items are only to be sold at full price (“Full Price Goods”).
5. Handling/positioning of goods, following acceptance by Coordinator, to be at the discretion of (and only by) persons designated by Coordinator.
6. Coordinator may, at any time, deem any goods (other than Full Price Goods) to be damaged, inferior or defective and sell/dispose of (i.e. clear) such items as seen fit.
7. Unsold goods to be collected from Stall by Supplier within 30 minutes of the advertised Finish Time. Such items not so collected may be disposed of at Coordinator’s discretion, and any proceeds retained.
8. Stall Operator shall provide Supplier with a detailed accounting of goods sold (or returned to Supplier), showing calculation of Net Proceeds.
9. In calculating the Net Proceeds, Stall Operator will deduct an agreed rate of commission on goods sold.
10. Stall Operator shall remit Net Proceeds to an agreed Account in the name of Supplier as soon as practicable after the Market.
11. Coordinator and Stall Operator make no guarantee as to saleability of goods and shall not be responsible for the degree of success of the Market.
12. Coordinator, Staff and Stall Operator shall take all reasonable care but accept no responsibility for theft or damage to goods on the Stall. Supplier may consider arranging Product Liability insurance and also registering with the NSW Food Authority.
13. In keeping with the concept of the Stall being a Community facility, it is expected that each Supplier will offer to help operate the Stall from time to time.
