### **Position Description**

#### **Nursery Hand**

The Gloucester Project (TGP) was constituted in 2008 as a non-profit organisation formed by community members concerned about climate change, land use, food and water security and the economic future of the community. TGP has been awarded a 3 year grant under the NSW Government's Community Builders program.

TGP will utilise the funds from this grant to provide horticultural encouragement and support for landholders to become food producers. TGP will be dedicated to providing growing and marketing support systems. The grant will also provide employment opportunities and skill development for under-employed and isolated rural community members, while also developing a user friendly support and information network. A program will also be designed to attract displaced and refugee growers to join the Gloucester community.

The Nursery Hand will assist with general nursery maintenance and seedling propagation. This position will entail some physical activity, including manual handling. The incumbent will need to be able to work with limited supervision. There will be an opportunity for accredited training in nursery management.
